We consider it important that children attending Dove Bank Primary School come to school in an appropriate form of dress, which will not only be functional but will help them to adopt a responsible attitude to the school and the task of learning. Our school uniform also signifies that we work as part of the Dove Bank team and the same rules and expectations are followed by everyone. Our school uniform is as follows:

- Royal blue sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece jacket with the school logo
- White or pale blue polo shirt or blouse
- Blue checked dress (optional for the Summer Term),
- Plain black or grey trousers or shorts
- Black or grey skirt/pinafore dress/culottes/uniform straight leg or boot cut trousers
- Black outdoor shoes (no sports trainers) which may be buckled, laced or slip-on
- Plain white/dark socks or navy/black/grey tights if desired



The school expects children to come to school with a suitable PE kit.

- A pair of blue or black shorts,
- Plain white t-shirt/polo shirt,
- Black/blue/white plimsolls or trainers
- Blue or black tracksuit/jogging bottoms and tracksuit top or Dove Bank hoodie,
- socks (if wearing tights to school).

Jewellery: Children may wear a simple analogue/digital watch or a fitness tracker style watch that encourages them to learn to read the time, but are not permitted to wear a Smart Watch or other similar style watches for safeguarding reasons. Those with pierced ears may wear sleepers or stud-type earrings only whilst in school. **No other form of jewellery is permitted in school.**

No jewellery can be worn in PE and pupils are expected to remove their own jewellery, including earrings, and any sort of watch. If earrings can't be removed then pupils must cover them prior to PE/swimming lessons.

Nail varnish and false nails: Children are not permitted to wear nail varnish or false nails of any sort.

Hair: Children with long hair should have it tied up. Hair accessories should be discrete, neat and sit flat to the head.

These rules are to ensure that the health and safety of our children is a priority at all times.
